

Good afternoon,

We wanted to provide you with an update about Cadent's pipeline diversion works off Rookery Lane.

Work to move our pipeline is progressing well. We are currently in the process of installing sections of the new pipe in the trenches we have dug on land either side of Rookery Lane.

We will also soon be starting to install the section of new pipe underneath Rookery Lane, using a boring technique that will enable us to keep Rookery Lane open to traffic. Before we can install the new section of pipe, we will be carrying out preparation activities at our works site.

This work will take place next week and involves digging shafts so that we can construct the tunnel under the road. While we dig the shafts there may be some noise, although this will be occasional.

Once we've finished installing the new pipe, we will then move on to connecting and testing the new pipe before completing all work in the autumn.

All of our work will take place during our usual working hours and we will continue to use our existing site access during this stage of works, avoiding use of village roads.

We will be in touch ahead of our testing activity to keep you updated.
