

Notice of Construction – Water Main Diversion in Bangley Lane, Hints, Tamworth B78 3EA

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. South Staffs Water will need to move underground water pipelines to allow for the construction of the new railway.

What are we doing?

South Staffs Water will be carrying out a diversion to an existing pipeline that runs in the carriageway of Bangley Lane adjacent to White House Farm. The pipeline supplies the local area and we need to carry out the work to continue to ensure a safe and reliable water supply during HS2 construction and ongoing operations.

The work will include:

1. Closure of Bangley Lane from both entrances off Sutton Road, with access maintained along Bangley Lane, but no through traffic. There will be signage showing diversionary routes via Sutton Road.
2. Construction of a new water main in the northern verge of Bangley Lane, adjacent to White House Farm.

How will this affect you?

The majority of vehicles being used will be Transit van size work vehicles, with some machinery being delivered to site using Large Goods Vehicles. We do not anticipate the level of these traffic movements will have any significant impact on the local road network. The below plan shows the extent and position of the road closure and diversion.



Duration of work

- The work is planned to take place between 6 April and 30 April 2021.
- Our working hours will be Monday – Friday from 8.00am to 6.00pm.
- We will be on-site one hour, either side of these times, for set-up and close-down.

What to expect

- Low levels of noise from our equipment.
- We may install signage on the roadside where we access our worksite.
- We will install temporary fencing to maintain a safe working environment.

What we will do

- Inform you in advance of any changes to these works.
- Keep all sites safe and secure.
